





Vrmac Hiking tour (Kotor – Vrmac – Kotor)

This hike travels along the spectacular Vrmac Ridge which divides the Bay of Kotor and the Bay of Tivat.

At the beginning, you'll be taken by a short transfer to an old village Gornja Lastva.

Overlooking Kotor in the bay you hike along the old Austro-Hungarian pathway which stretches along the ridge with stunning views on both sides of the inner and outer bays. The first part of the hike is mostly on flat ground through forests, gradually ascending on the stone pathweay to a more exposed area with views to the inner Bay of Kotor and then turning to the other side of the ridge with views towards the Adriatic and Tivat. After about 3 hours of hiking, you will be able to see an old Austro-hungarian fortress Vrmac wher the entire group make a short pause.





Exploring the Fort Vrmac

Fort Vrmac is one of the best preserved Austro-Hungarian fortresses in Boka Kotorska. It was established in 1860, but the present structure was built between 1894 and 1897. In those times, the fortress provided accommodation for the soldiers, but there were also ammunition magazines, cisterns, hospitals... The big grey buildings are in surprisingly good condition considering they have been left to the ravages of time. The windows are covered with rusty bars and the perimeter is riddled with large metal spikes, rising from the chaotic weedy ground.


At the end of the hike, you'll be taken by a short transfer to Kotor. Estimated time: 3 hours











LUNCH IN RESTAURANT CATTARO, Kotor

Cattaro Hotel is located in the heart of the medieval, seaside Old Town of Kotor. Situated on the town's main square, it occupies a significant portion of the town's walls...

Cattaro complex is situated in three different city buildings: Providur's palace (who was a local authority in period of time when Venetians were in govern of this part of Adriatic coast, until 1806.), Town Guard and Napoleon's Theatre (which was build in 1810).

KOTOR GUIDED TOUR

ST.TRYPHON CTAHEDRAL is Romanesque church consecrated in 1166, extensively restored several times, especially after the 1667 earthquake when the bell towers and a part of the façade were destroyed. New bell towers were made in the Baroque style, and until today they remained of different shape. St.Tryphon is considered to be patron saint of Kotor.

MARITIME MUSEUM has grown out of the collection founded by the "Boka Marine" Fraternity, Baroque palace of the noble Grgurina family from the beginning of the 18th century, was completely restored and adapted to meet the needs of the Museum.

ST.NICOLA CHURCH The biggest orthodox church in the region was built on foundations of previous Dominican monastery. The construction was ended in 1909,an the special value in the church is iconostasis of the church made in 1908.





Follow the road of King Nikola by coach Arrival at Old Royal Capital THE OLD ROYAL CAPITAL - CETINJE

In the **Old capital Cetinje**, today almost deserted heart of Montenegro, city that fell asleep after II World War, lies numerous possibilities for history loving visitors.

Strolling down the city center, all the sights are easily accessible: well preserved Palace of King Nikola, old embassies of all countries, monasteries and churches where two of the most famous Christian relics are kept - the right hand of St. John the Baptist, a piece of the True Cross, the chest of St. Petar Cetinjski and a rich collection of icons, rich paintings and ethnographic collection, war trophies.







VISIT KING NIKOLA'S RESIDENCE

King Nikola's Museum was founded in 1926, within the residence of the last Montenegrin ruler Nikola I Petrovic Njegoš, in continuation of the tradition of collecting and carefully preserving the materials on the Montenegrin past.

The construction started in 1863 and was completed around 1867. However, it is known for a fact that the original purpose of the building was to accommodate the widow and daughter of Prince Danilo.

After Darinka left Montenegro, this residence obtained a new function. Members of the royal family moved from Biljarda to the new "palace", as Montenegrins used to call it.







DEPARTURE TO NATIONAL PARK LOVCEN

NP Lovcen located in rocky region of Dinara Alps. Slopes of Mountain Lovcen steeply, rise from coastal region of Budva and west part of Cetinje. Park is bordered on South with highway Budva — Cetinje and on North with old Kotor road.

"Black Mountain", after which Montenegro got its name, rises to 1749 meters of altitude. Park is 6220 acres large.





MAUSOLEUM OF NJEGOS

The largest and most important monument of the National Parks of Lovcen is Njegos' Mausoleum. Petar II Petrovic-Njegos was a Prince-Bishop of Montenegro, a Serbian Orthodox Metropolitan of Cetinje, a philosopher and poet, whose work is considered responsible for the modernization of Montenegro.

This unique monument is located at the highest point of the top named Jezerski vrh, which Njegos was chosen for his burial place.

The mausoleum of the greatest Montenegrin poet and ruler Petar Petrović Njegoš (1813. -1851), represents a highlight of the visit to the National Park "Lovćen". Mausoleum can be reached by the 20 kilometer road from Cetinje, followed by









Apart from its unusual and extraordinary beauty, historical and cultural reasons prevailed for it to become a National Park.

The highest is the peak Štirovnik - 1.749 m above the sea level, which is also the highest peak of the mountain Lovćen. Authentic national architecture can be seen in this region: katuns — summer settlements of farmers and old stone houses with roofs made of sawn straw or laminar limestone, village guvna - places where folk meetings were held, were people celebrated and enjoyed themselves.



The National Park "Durmitor" spreads across 39000 ha, and its area of 20000 ha has been included in the UNESCO since 1980. It is surrounded by 23 mountain peaks over 2300m high. There are 17 glacier lakes called "mountain eyes" in the area of Durmitor. The most famous is the Black Lake covered with ice and crystals of frozen snowflakes in the winter. You can swim in the middle of the summer. Ledena pecina (the Ice Cave), located under the peak Obla Glava, 2100 m above sea level, represents the fascinating natural phenomena. There are snowy areas in the highest parts of Durmitor even in the middle of summer, and you can ski in the area of Velika Kalica.

The Tara River Canyon is the largest and deepest canyon in Europe. Tara bridge is a unique architectural structure. For a long time, he held the leading position as the tallest object of the arch type. The maximum height of the object is 172 meters — this is the distance from the surface of the bridge to the smooth surface of the Tara River.







In the middle of **Biogradska Gora**, there is maybe the most romantic Lake Biograd.

The Lake is 1.100m long and 410m wide, and it is extremely abundant with fish, especially trout. During the spring and summer, the best way for you to familiarise yourself with this area is to walk down a 3km long walking trail surrounding the Lake.



SKADAR LAKE

National Park Skadar Lake is located in the valley just 7km far from the sea. Two thirds of it belongs to Montenegro and 1/3 is located on Albanian territory.

Depending on the water level, the lake surface varies from 370 to 530km2.

The lake has crypt-depression which means that some parts of its bottom are below sea level. Lake is filled by Morača River and drained into the Adriatic see by the 41km long Buna/Bojana River, which forms the international border on the lower half of its length.

DISCOVER RIJEKA CRNOJEVICA

Rijeka Crnojevića - meaning the "River of Crnojević", is a town in Montenegro on the eponymous Rijeka Crnojevića river, near the coast of Skadar lake. A small town on the same river is one of the most beautiful small towns in Montenegro. Throughout history, the river Crnojevic was very important for the then Montenegro. Today, over 200 citizens live in this town. The remains of historic buildings from the time of Ivan Crnojevic are preserved in the place, such as the basement room which is linked to the work of the Obod Printing Office, where the first Cyrillic book "Oktoih prvoglasnik" was published in 1494.

The building that is especially attractive to tourists visiting Rijeka Crnojevica is the Danilo Bridge.

BUDVA RIVIERA

In the heart of the Adriatic coast of Montenegro, there is a town called Budva, made for living and enjoyment.

BUDVA CITY TOUR

The archeological museum in the Old Town, located in an early 19th century building, boasts the collection over 1,200 relics and the ethnological collection of more than 450 different exhibits from ancient times to 20th C.

Holy Trinity Church is situated in the middle of the biggest square in the Old Town, surrounded by 3 older churches. Thus orthodox church represents unique point of interest due to its marvelous fresco paintings and iconostasis.

The Citadel built in 840 AD is the keeper of Budva history. It occupies museum, observation deck, library and part of city walls.
